



- From 2018-2019 to 2023-2024, the average February pressing accounted for 66.93% of the final Gujarat pressing. The highest pressing in percentage was recorded in the 2020-21 season at 79.21%, with a similar trend observed in 2021-22.
- In the 2021-22 season, despite a lower crop yield, farmers opted to sell kapas (seed cotton) faster than average selling. However, in the following year (2022-23), despite a significantly larger crop compared to 2021-22, farmers were reluctant to sell, resulting in slow pressing till 28th February, only 48.19% of the final pressing was done by February end.
- Due to the Cotton Corporation of India (CCI) MSP operations, mainline pressing was above average. Consequently, all other three zones, Saurashtra, North Gujarat, and Kutch were running below their usual average pressing.
- In Saurashtra, 375 ginning factories were active during the season, but by February, only 312 remained operational, indicating that 63 factories had halted operations due to market disparity. Similarly, in North Gujarat, out of 159 active ginning units, only 137 continued operating in February, with 22 factories remained closed during February month. Uncertain market condition also contribute to the lower pressing condition.
- Currently, around 100 ginning factories are processing cotton for CCI in Gujarat. As of February 28th, CCI had procured 10,66,000 running bales equivalent kapas in Gujarat, out of which around 9,75,000 running bales were pressed till 28th February 2025, while 91,000 bales equivalent remained in kapas form. In February alone, CCI pressing amounted to 2,75,000 running bales.
- Meanwhile, approximately 388 factories were operating in the private sector, pressing a total of 7,53,504 running bales in February. This translates to an average of 69 bales processed per factory per day over 28 days.













